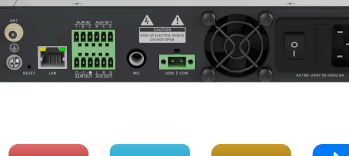

INTRODUCTION

GEN-5302P12 is a network digital amplifier designed for IP public address and network audio reinforcement systems. It integrates standard network audio transmission, SIP intercom, Bluetooth input, local audio storage, and power amplification in one unit. Supporting standard network protocols and up to 20 multicast streams, the amplifier features a built-in Class-D amplifier with 100V / 120W constant-voltage output for flexible connection to distributed loudspeaker systems. It supports multiple audio input sources including AUX, MIC, Bluetooth, and network audio, and can be configured and managed remotely via web interface or DevConfig Tool. It is suitable for indoor public address applications such as schools, shopping malls, office buildings, campuses, and transportation hubs.

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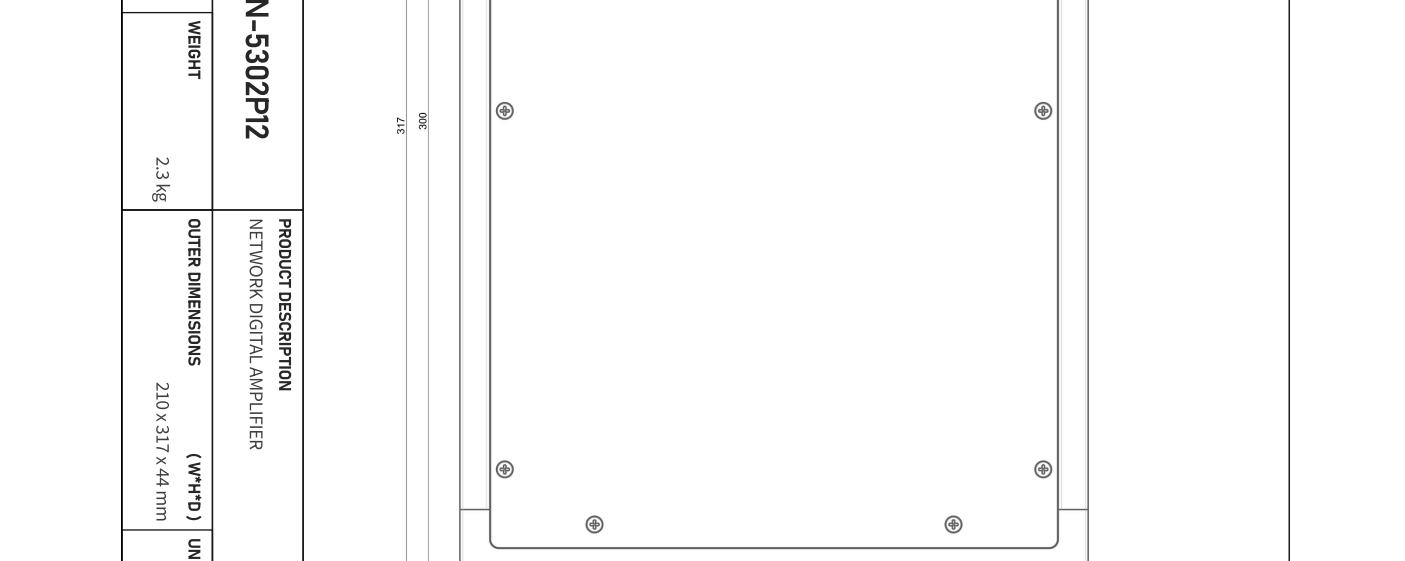
CONNECTION DIAGRAM



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APPLICATION 1
